School Crossing Patrol

Jeni Neil and Victoria Coleman presented the facts re: School Crossing Patrol and the implications for students attending educational establishments in Moulton. Following a lengthy discussion the following action points were agreed:

- John Clarke to write on behalf of the Community Panel to Cllr Andre Gonzalez De Savage and copy in Northamptonshire County Councillor Judy Shephard
- Parish councils to also write to Cllr Andre Gonzalez De Savage and copy in Cllr J Shephard
- Overstone and Boughton parish councils to agenda item to address the possibility of a financial contribution to the SCP in Moulton
- Mike explained that the SCT cannot commit to patrolling the area on a regular basis

2. Minutes of last meeting

Agreed as a correct record.

3. Matters arising

Gill presented the following progress report: **Travel in Moulton and surrounding areas Recommendations**

1. Discuss with the Joint Planning Unit (JPU), DDC, and NCC the need to provide a new public road off the A43 to take traffic away from Moulton and Holcot Villages.

Report sent to NCC leader, cabinet members and officers-to be discussed at cabinet meeting.

2. Encourage Moulton College to explore opportunities to create a college access off the A508 to take college traffic away from Pitsford and Boughton villages.

Report sent to, and discussed with, Moulton College. Opportunities being explored. Feedback from some residents expressing a concern that a college drive might be a precursor to development. Conditions preventing development would therefore need to be applied to any planning application.

3. Lobby NCC re: the need to develop and consult on a strategic road plan for Northampton and the surrounding area.

As per recommendation 1.

4. Engage with JPU and NCC re: opportunities to develop a new secondary school within the proposed 2000 home development at Overstone, which will negate the need for a secondary school in Moulton village.

Report sent to Cllr Andrew Grant, Cabinet member for schools. Awaiting meeting to be attended by John Clarke, Trevor Jones and Gill Newton

5. Encourage Northampton University to discuss with relevant planning authorities the possibility of creating a vehicular access into Park Campus from Kings Park Road.

University will include this in their strategic plan. NBC officers have not responded to a request for meeting. Report sent to NBC Cllr for Kingsthorpe-awaiting response.

6. Request Moulton College and Northampton University finalise their master plans for estate development and associated infrastructure and that these documents accompany any future planning applications.

Plans being finalised-update at next community panel meeting.

7. Request DDC provide full civil enforcement of parking in Moulton Village should decriminalisation take place in 2012.

Report sent to Ian Vincent, CEO Daventry DC, awaiting response.

4. Feedback on Community priority (and any other tasks)

a. Police Report

Since the last meeting, 17 speed enforcement visits have taken place outside Brampton Primary School resulting in 8 tickets and 15 vehicles being stopped and warned. Very positive feedback received from parents and residents.
